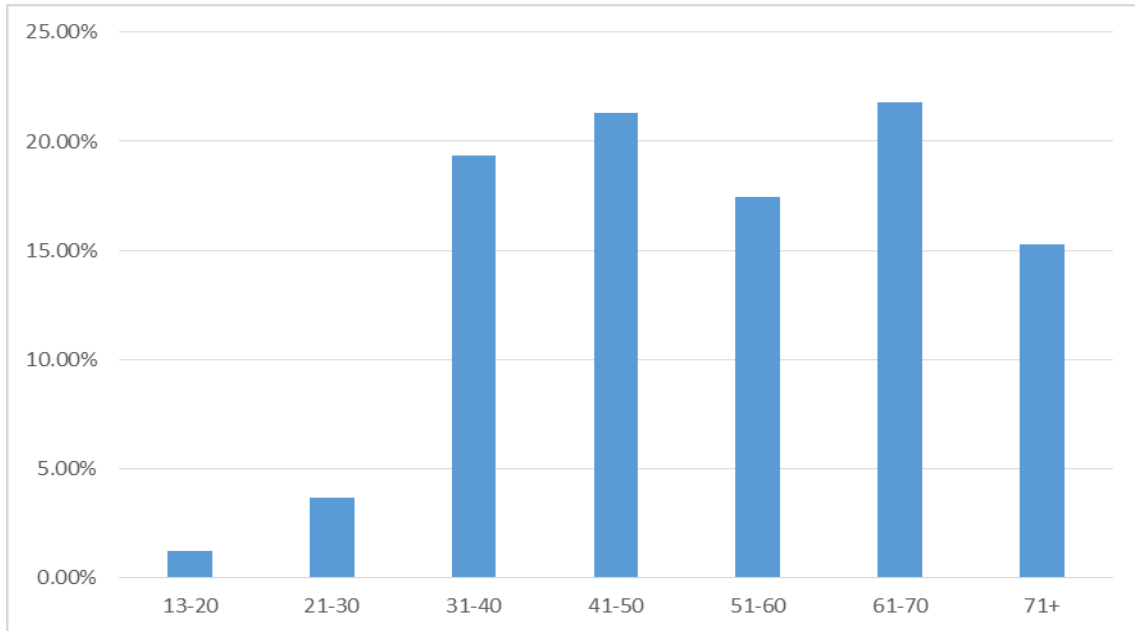
Master Planning Survey Summary

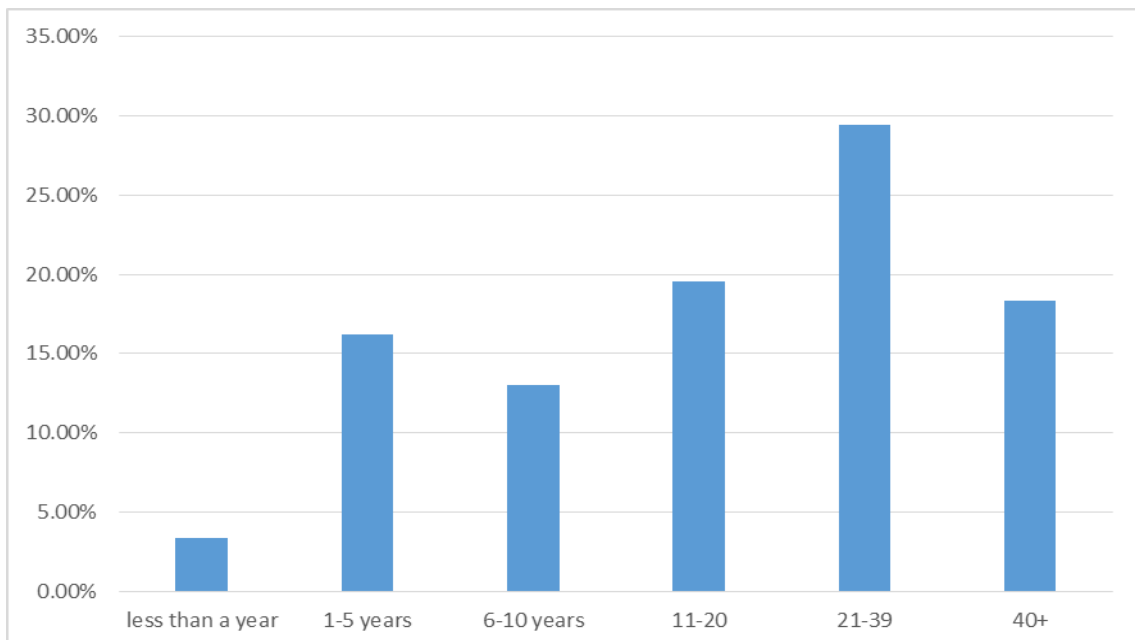

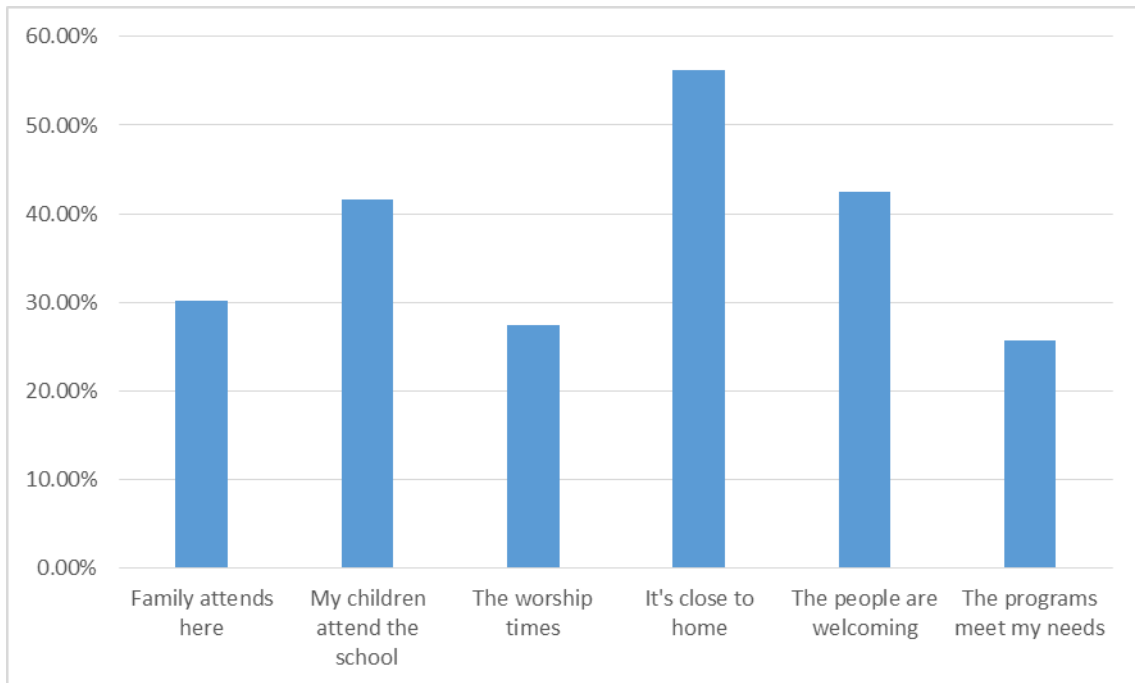
How long have you been a member of the Parish Community?

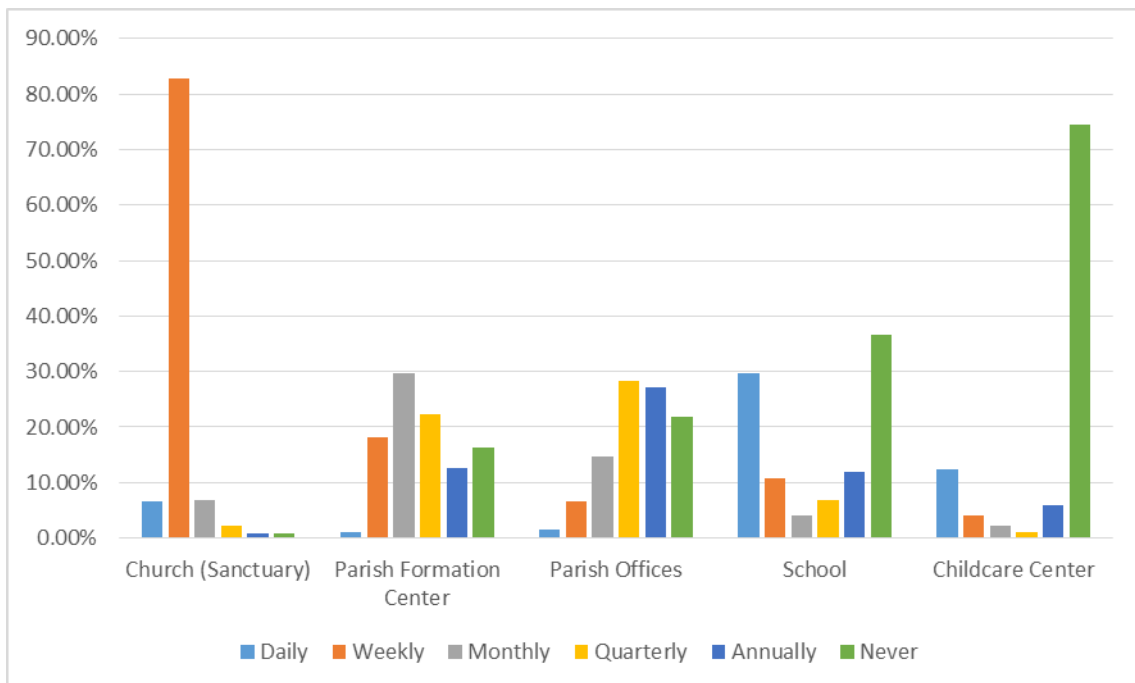

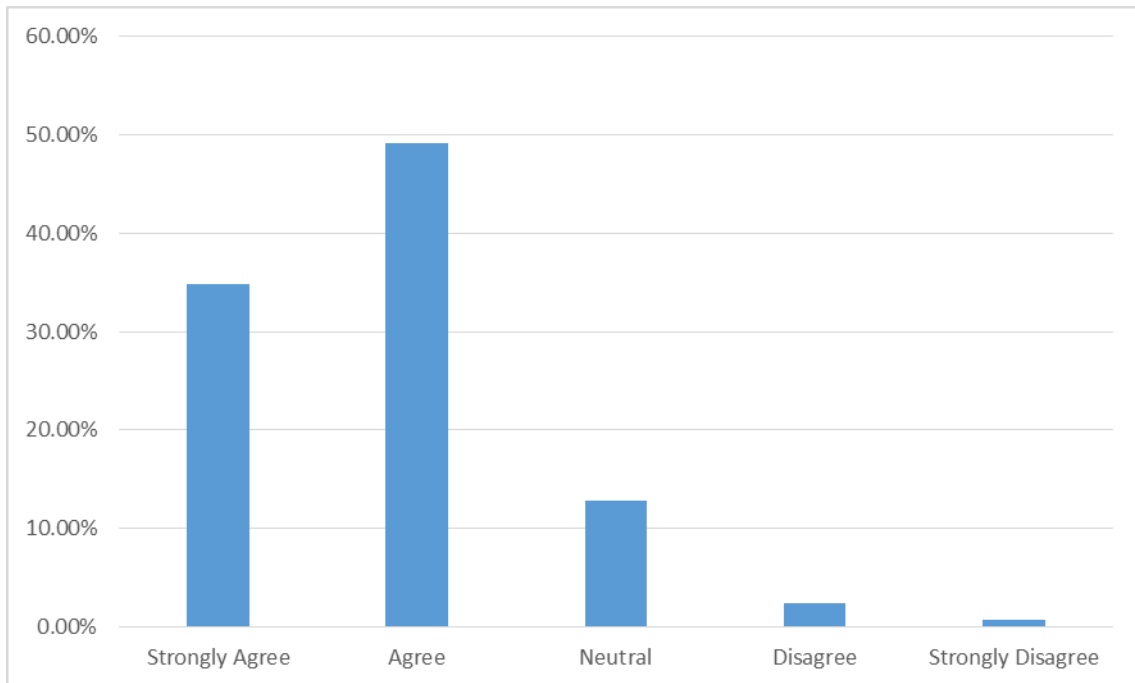

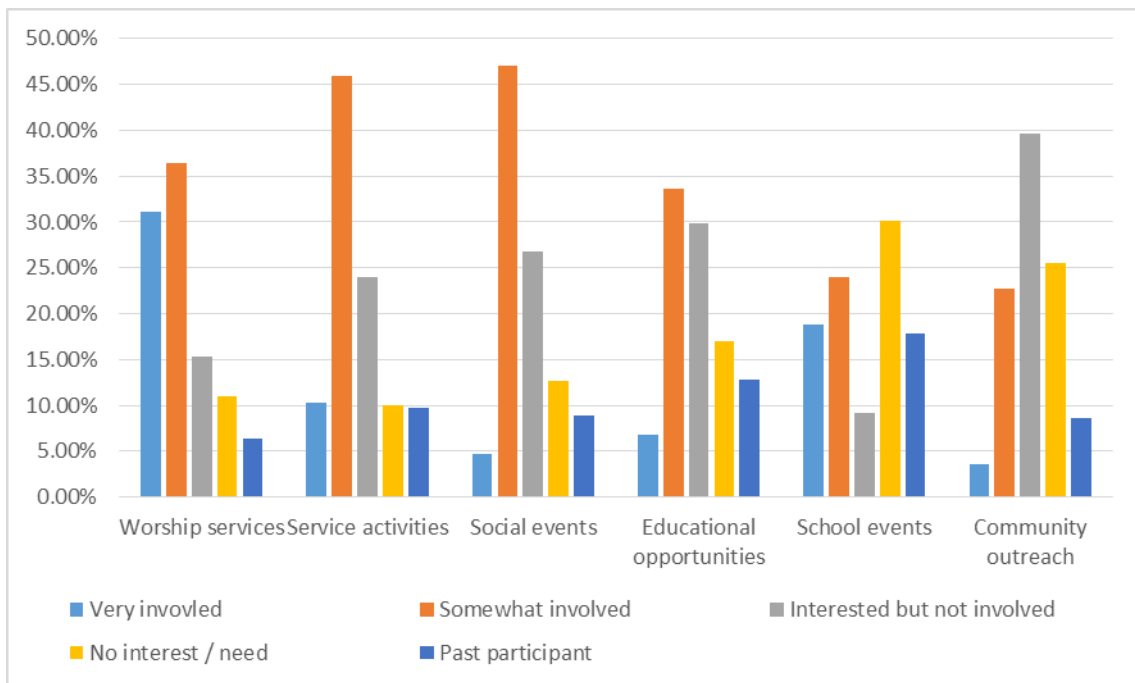

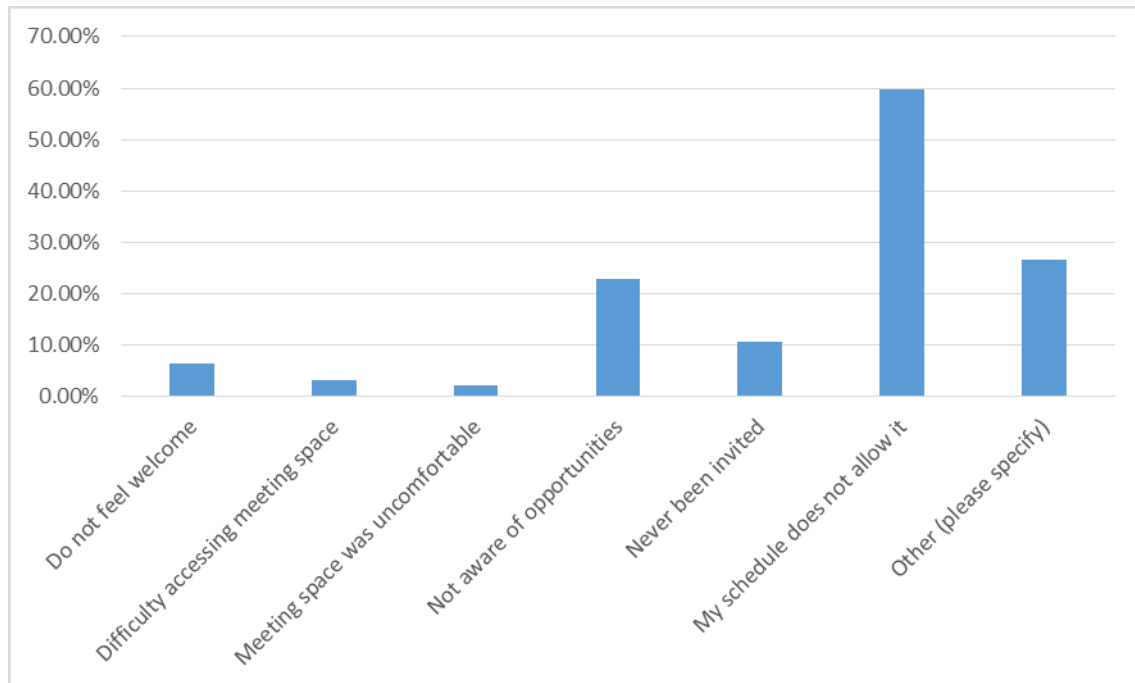
Please indicate how involved you are in the following activities

SECTION 2: Building Ratings and Comments

Section two focuses on each facility contained within the Most Pure Heart of Mary campus (with the exception of the current Rectory and Convent). We asked participants to rate the facilities on a scale of 1-5 (1=Poor/needs improvement, 3= Neutral, 5=Excellent). While rating each building, the participants were given the option to say “don’t know” for any of these items:

Appearance - How inviting or welcoming is the building / area?

Accessibility - Parking and pedestrian routes to and from the building?

Usability - (Signage / wayfinding) How easy is it to find your way around?

Functionality - Space is adequate to fill the parish community's needs?

Lighting and audio systems function well?

Temperature - Interior temperatures are comfortable?

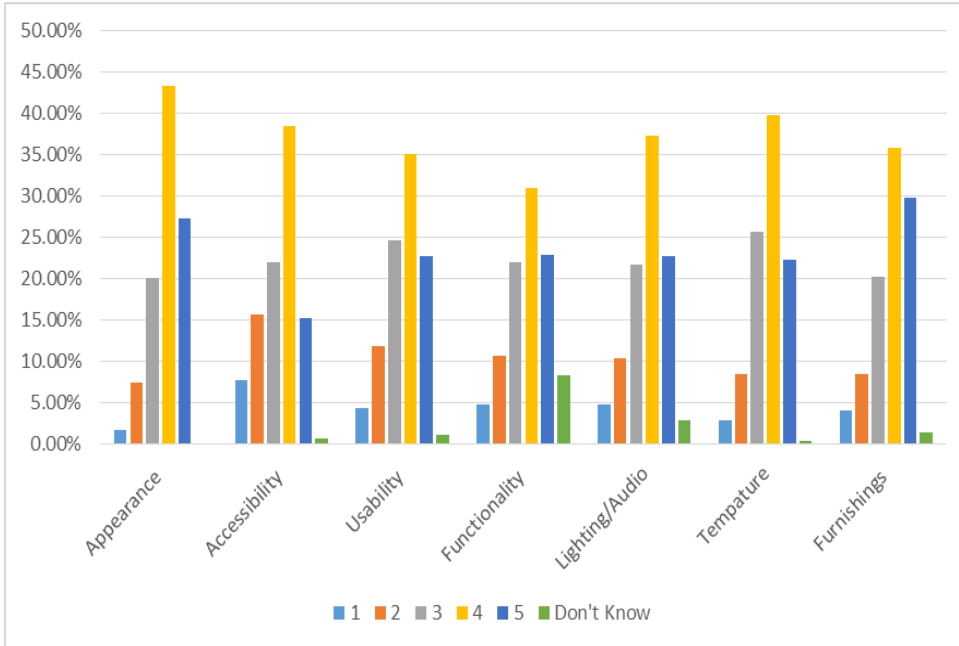
Furnishings are clean and well taken care of?

After rating, participants had the opportunity to provide a free form response. Many of these responses touched upon multiple items. In order to include every item that was brought up during comments, each response was categorized and rated based on the number of times that comment came up. When, two items were brought up during a single comment, each item was counted in it’s appropriate category.

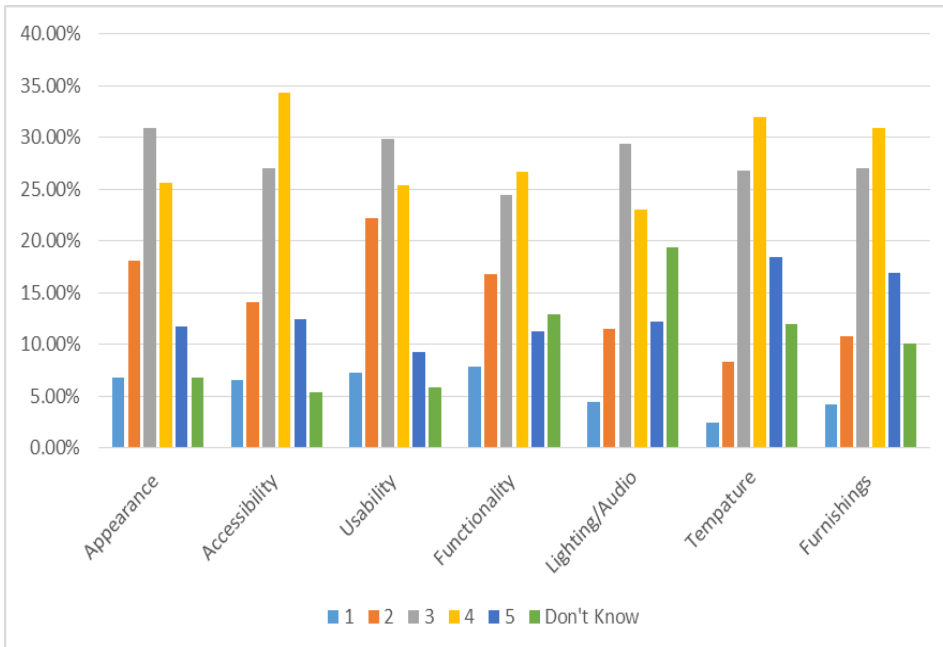

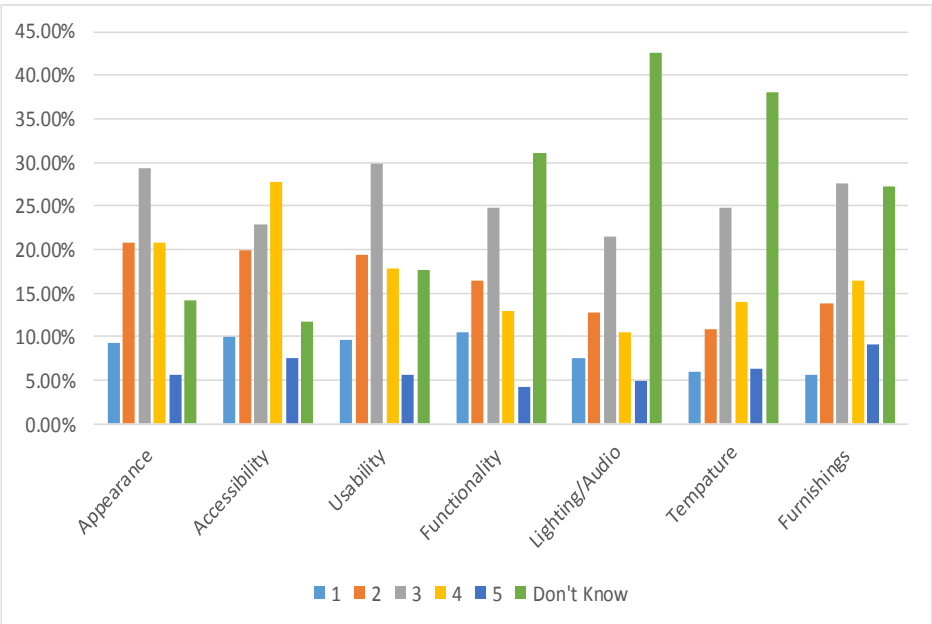

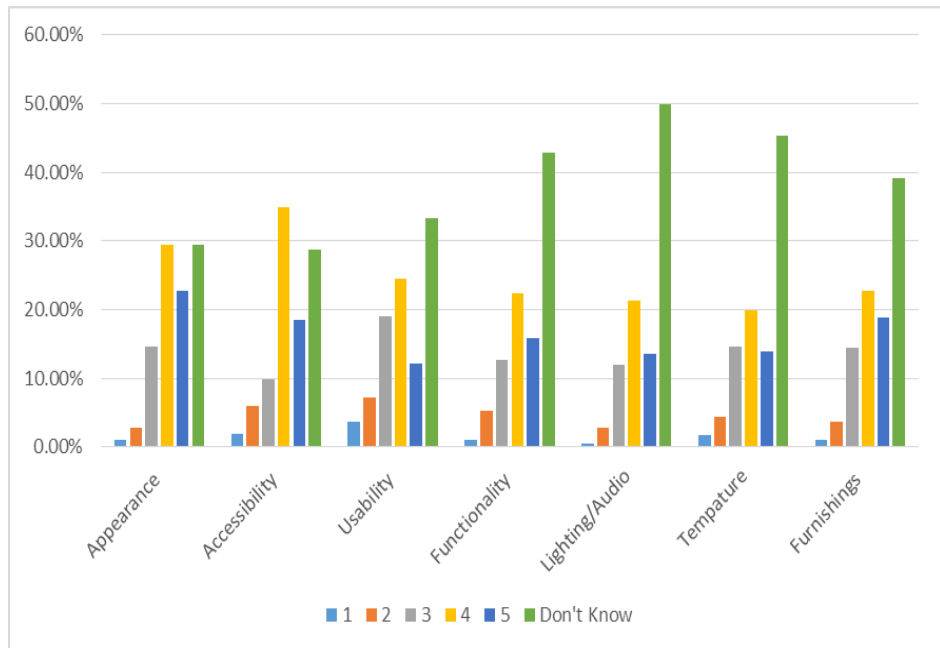

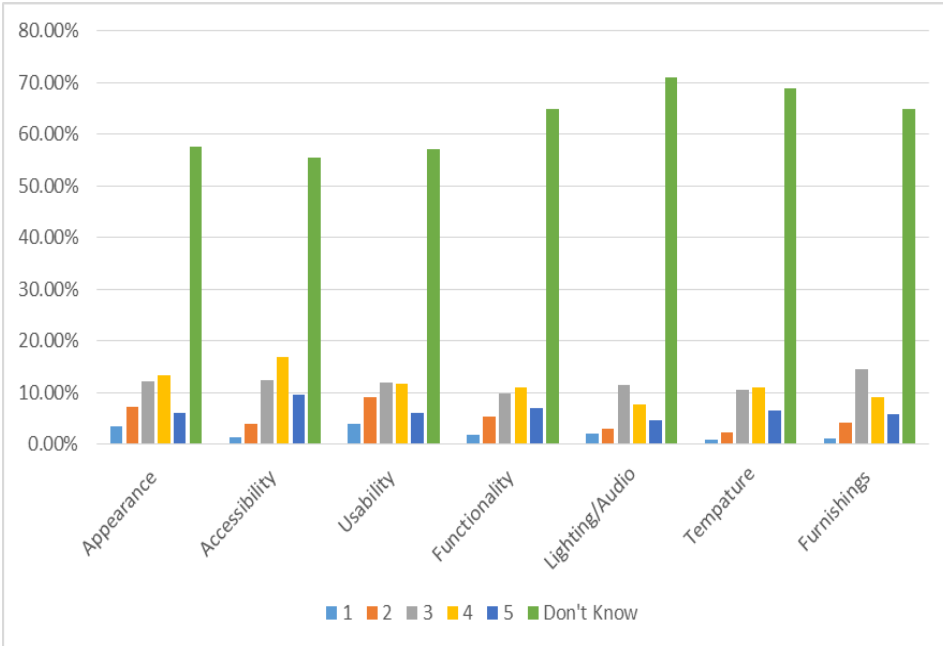

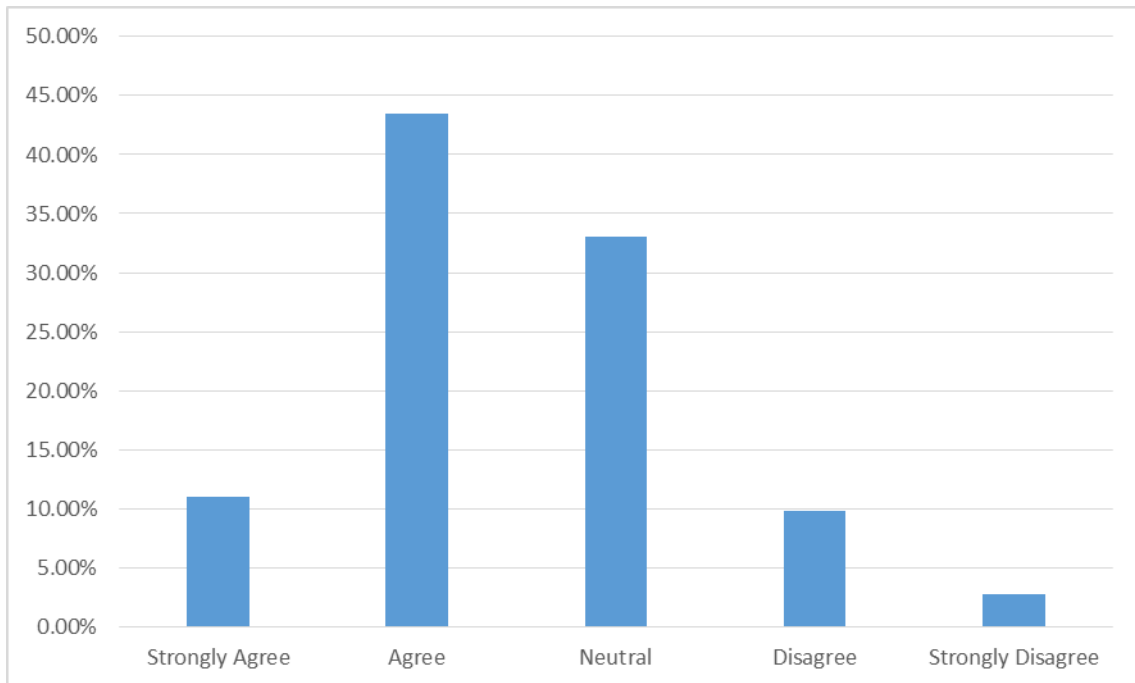

- Wish list - Tear everything down and start over and have 1 building.
- Have a freestanding Adoration Chapel. Have decent bathrooms. Have a gathering space at the entrance to church. More accessible parking. Clean up and maintain what we have before starting a major project.
- Better bathrooms. Extend nave, make larger. Redo entire choir loft. Remodel/update kitchen in OCCC for school and church use.
- Implement a pleasing functional transitional environment with a decent workable kitchen and a pleasant orderly gathering space.
- Attach formation center to church so you do not have to go outside to get to the center. (2)
- St Vincent's meeting room in basement needs more comfortable chairs please.
- Make Stone's Folly into some kind of nice memorial.
- Meeting rooms updated to fit where technology is but also having more sacred art... joining the best of the past with the tech of today.
- Need for a good cry room for young children and families.
- It would be great to see the daycare updated - it is older and doesn't match the newer appeal of the school.
