When to Wash Hands:

Before, during, and after preparing food

Before eating

Before and after caring for someone who is sick

Before and after treating a cut or wound

After using the rest room

After changing a diaper or assisting a child who has used the rest room

After blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing

After touching an animal or animal waste

After touching garbage

How to Wash Hands:

Wet hands with clean, running water (warm or cold) and encourage your child to scrub both the

front and back of their hands, between their fingers, and under their nails

Rub hands together for 20 seconds (a good point of reference is singing the "Happy Birthday" song twice)

For more information on the CDC's hand-washing initiative, Rinse hands well

Dry hands thoroughly with a clean towel or air dry them
