Monday February 26 2018 enrollment begins! The first 2 weeks of enrollment are only for current KCDC families to enroll for next school year. Starting March 12, open enrollment will begin. The enrollment form must be completed AND the \$50 deposit received at the same time for your child(ren) to be officially enrolled for the 2018 fall school year.
